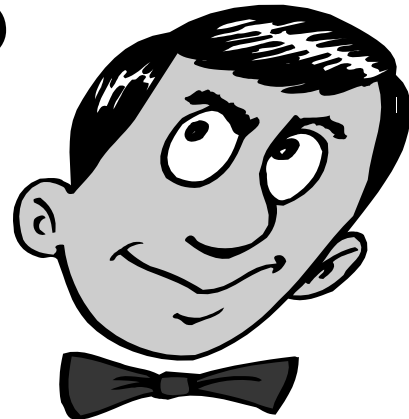




Old Paint Disposal Got You Puzzled?

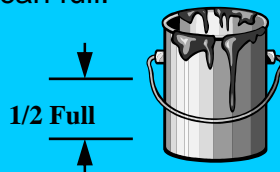
Today’s the day and here’s how.....



Pry off the lids on the cans and take a look inside.



If there is more than a half a can of paint, pour into another less filled can until you have no more than a half of a can full.

Add “Kitty Litter” or “Oil Dry” and stir until the paint gets as thick as oatmeal.



Be sure to leave the **lids off** of the can so the Public Works solid waste collectors can see the paint has been prepared properly.

Place the paint cans on the curb/ alley line on your regular solid waste collection day.
