

The following information is required when applying for an electrical permit with the City of Racine:

- 1. Copy of your State of Wisconsin Electrical Contractor License.**
- 2. Copy of the owner or employee's Wisconsin Master Electrician License.**
- 3. Copy of the employee's Wisconsin electrical license that will be working in Racine.**

Also be aware that the City of Racine has an electrical Rewire Ordinance when changing or altering an electrical service.

Permits for electrical work are issued to electrical contractors who hold a valid electrical contractor's license issued by the State of Wisconsin. Employees working for them must also hold an individual electrician's license.

You need an electrical permit any time electrical wiring is installed, altered, extended, or connected to any electrical equipment.
