

Bulky Waste Handling Options

Pick-ups performed by trucks with lifting equipment for worker safety, and size limitations may be imposed (such as the amount of waste that can be loaded in 5 minutes)

Option 1: Call-in Bulky Waste Pick-Ups

- Some number of free pick-ups provided to each residence at no cost each quarter, fee may be charged for additional pick-ups
- Call-ins entered into scheduling/routing software
- Customer provided date/instructions for set-out

Option 2: Scheduled Bulky Waste Pick-Ups

- Pick-ups scheduled one day each month or quarter for each route

Bulky/Yard Waste Drop-Off Center(s)

- Center(s) open several days per week, 52 weeks per year
- Free drop-off of bulky and yard wastes for city residents
- Standard fees for drop-off of regulated wastes (appliances, electronics, tires, etc.)

Other Options Being Considered

Restoring holiday pick-up schedule

- Avoids cart overflows resulting from two-week Solid Waste and four-week Recycling collection periods

Four day per week, 10-hour day collection schedule

- Increases worker productivity
- Facilitates holiday pick-up scheduling

Single-side (street) pick-up (coordinated with alternate side parking restrictions)

- Significantly reduces conflicts between parked cars and cart placement
- Increases worker productivity
- Reduces fuel consumption/CO2 emissions
- Requires restructuring of alternate side parking schedule, i.e. from day of the month to day of the week
