


Neighborhood Greenways

Neighborhood Greenways are residental streets with low traffic volumes and speeds where bicyclists and pedestrians are given priority. They reduce cut-through traffic, reduce traffic speeds, and guide bicyclists and pedestrians to destinations.

Bicycle lanes are a marked lane dedicated to bicycle use. Typically five to six feet wide, bike lanes often make cyclists and motorists more comfortable by providing space for each type of user.
