[REDACTED] stated he was informed that King had been killed in the area. I advised Sgt. Comstock of this via radio and Inv. Rybarik responded to the area to speak with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] did not reveal any further details of how he received his information.

I remained on scene in the 1100b of Center St. and 800b of 12th St. and assisted with scene security until I was relieved of my duties by Sgt. Garcia.

On 05-20-22 Ofc Trousil and I were operating marked patrol squad K9-5. I am currently training Ofc Trousil and while on patrol we heard Ofc Brenner try to make a traffic stop. Ofc Brenner then came across the radio saying a male was fleeing on foot north bound through the yards. Ofc Brenner radioed out that he had shots fired and one person at gun point. Ofc Trousil was operating K9-5 and he responded to the area emergency lights and siren. When we arrived on scene Sgt Comstock radioed out that he had enough officers on scene with the suspect and that the vehicle he fled from needed to be secured. Ofc Trousil and I arrived on scene and we observed Ofc Brenners unmarked squad car partly in the driveway of 910 12th St with the emergency lights activated. I then observed a gray VW [REDACTED] in the driveway. I did not know if anyone else was in the vehicle so I had my duty weapon out and pointed at the suspect vehicle. Ofc Trousil, Benitez and I cleared the vehicle with no one inside of this vehicle. We had several other officers out with us so I decided to respond to Ascension to advise medical staff of the OIS and that the suspect was going to be transported to the hospital. I drove to the hospital emergency lights and siren to ensure I arrived before the rescue squad.

When I arrived at the hospital I observed Ofc Reinhold and Powell in the ER. I briefed the hospital staff and Ofc's Powell and Reinhold about the OIS. I went back out to my squad car and Sgt

Comstock contacted me over the radio requesting that I make the scene with my K9 dog Ramon. I went back into the hospital and I advised Ofc Reinhold that after the suspect was taken out of the rescue squad to make sure an officer searches the back of the squad to make sure no evidence is left in the squad. I responded back to the scene and I met Sgt Comstock on Carol St in a open grass field.

Sgt Comstock pointed out where the suspect was at one the ground and pointed out a handgun laying in the grass near a shirt the suspect had been wearing. Sgt Comstock did not know where Ofc Brenner was at in the field when he discharged his weapon. I went back to my squad car to get K9 Ramon to deploy him. K9 Ramon is a certified Explosive Detection K9 and is certified in the detection of smokeless powder. Smokeless powder is inside of ammunition prior to being fired off.

I deployed K9 Ramon and he began to search the area that had been cut and a area that had not been cut. Ramon began to search this area in general sniffing behavior and he never went into alert behavior. Ramon did try to go over to the handgun that was laying in the grass that belonged to the suspect due to smelling the smokeless powder inside of the this gun. Ramon never went into alert behavior. I was giving Ramon a break and I learned that the suspect was deceased and it was requested that I stop searching for the spent casings until it was learned what police agency was going to take over the investigation. Sgt Comstock released Ofc Trousil and I from the scene at 1500 hours.

**NARRATIVE**

This report supplements the incident report under this complaint number.

On 05-20-2022 I, Ofc. Powell 6694 was at Ascension emergency room at 3801 Spring Street on a Mental Subject call x ref-22-19606. I left my call and patient to assist with security of sally port doors at the emergency room as Ofc. De. Cecchini came into the emergency room and informed me and hospital staff that there had been an officer involved shooting involving Racine Police.

I then left my patient and responded to the ambulance bay sally port doors and stood by and guarded the ambulance bay doors with Ofc. Juopperi. As I did so, an ambulance that was carrying the patient, later fast ID'd by Mount Pleasant PD as Dashontay L. King, arrived. Racine Fire Department rescue personnel then transported King from the ambulance into emergency trauma room 14. I then brought brown paper bags and handed them to hospital staff inside room 14 to place King's clothing into for evidence collection. Hospital staff did so and gave me the brown paper bags which were then handed into the custody of R. Tredo using gloved hands.

I then stood by the ambulance bay doors as more RAPD and other jurisdiction's personnel arrived to assist as I was informed the family of King were beginning to arrive at the hospital.

After securing the doors, I was commanded by LT Powell to relieve Ofc. Reinhold in guarding the body of Dashontay King, which was in RAZ room 10 at the emergency room. I sat in a chair outside of the room with Ofc. R. Tredo until Milwaukee Police Department, Division of Criminal Investigations and Lt. Powell came back to the room. I was then informed that my body worn camera could be turned off by Lt. Powell as Milwaukee PD was going to speak to Ofc R. Tredo

**NARRATIVE**

On May 20th, 2022, at approximately 1310 hours, I, Officer REINHOLD, was working for the Racine Police Department in full uniform, body camera worn, in marked R25. I was at Ascension Hospital in the City of Racine, County of Racine, State of Wisconsin for a mental subject.

While near the family room with the patient I observed Ofc. Dennis Cecchini enter the ER via the sally-port. Ofc. Dennis Cecchini informed myself and Ofc. C Powell that Ofc. Brenner was involved in a shooting. Ofc. Brenner was not injured though.

Ofc. Dennis Cecchini informed medical staff that there was going to be a gunshot wound entering the hospital.

Officers made contact with hospital security in regards to locking certain doors to prevent extended family causing problems.

As Racine Fire and EMS arrived in the sally port, a paramedic exited the ambulance and mentioned they were "calling it". Indicating that the male in the ambulance was deceased. Racine Fire and EMS eventually conveyed Dashontay King's body to a room. As EMS entered the ER, I went into

Inv. Blackmore, Inv. Diener, and I were later handed blood soaked blankets/sheets that were used in the ambulance. Using a hazmat bag we shook out the three blood soaked blankets and only located IV, medication caps.

Inv. Blackmore took the blankets and disposed of the blankets.

I later stood by at the hospital to provide security until I was relieved and ordered to make the police department for crowd control.

**SUMMARY**

**NARRATIVE**

On Day of the week, 05/20/22 at approximately 1301 hours, I, Ofc Morris #10231 was working for the City of Racine Police Department (RPD) wearing full departmental uniform and operating fully marked Racine Police Vehicle R15. I was wearing my department issued Body Worn Camera (BWC). I was under the guidance of FTO Nabors #2722.

On the above date and time and at the Police Department, I heard a radio transmission stating that a male was running and that shots had been fired. I proceeded to my squad car and activated R15's emergency lights and sirens.

On scene, I observed RPD officers securing the male in handcuffs behind his back. RPD officers proceeded to turn the male over onto his back. The RPD officers began basic life saving measures, CPR. During this time, I observed what appeared to be a semi auto handgun, olive green in color, laying in the grass approximately 6 feet from where the male was laying. I was instructed to stay by the handgun by FTO Nabors. In addition, I was given items that were found in the male's pockets by Sgt. Comstock. RPD officers retrieved a small brown paper bag and I placed them into the bag. The bag was given to Sgt. Garcia.
