Once on scene, I observed King being handcuffed by other officers and officers rendering aid. I then assisted Ofc Brenner and checked his welfare until I was advised to bring Ofc Brenner back to the PD by Deputy Chief Toeller.

NARRATIVE

On (05/20/22) I, Ofc B Nabors #2722 was on duty in the city of Racine in full police uniform operating marked police vehicle R-15.

At (1302) hrs. I responded to Carrol St referencing Ofc Brenner being in a foot chase with shots fired.

Upon arrival I observed a suspect later id'd as Dashontay King lying on the ground while other officers were handcuffing him and providing first aid (CPR). I then observed a semi-automatic handgun laying just east and a few feet from where King was laying. I advised Ofc Morris to stay with the weapon while I turned my attention to Ofc Brenner to make sure he was ok and checked his welfare.

Deputy Chief Toeller then gave me the ok to bring Ofc Brenner back to the station and await further instructions. Inv Scarvers took over the duties of Ofc Morris in guarding the weapon lying in the grass.

Ofc Brenner was then brought to the police station.
